# 3. Key Activities of 5-Day 'Training of Trainers Workshop'

# 3.1 Prayers & Dars -e- Qur 'an:

Since it was a residential training program in which majority of the participants were female teachers, we had deputed female group leaders to ensure the prescribed agenda for prayers and Dars -e- Qur 'an. Each day started with the Fajar Prayer, followed by a Dars -e- Qur 'an class led by the highly knowledgeable and seasoned scholar of Islam 'Ms. Aneela Saba'. The objective is indeed to help these teachers to become a Mu 'allima. Similarly, Dars -e- Qur 'an for male participants was led by Mr. Amir Zeb (Director Training & Services - AFAQ) and Mr. Fazal Elahi Awan (Senior Manager Training – AFAQ).

# 3.2 Introduction of Participants:

# 5. Introduction of ESEF

ESEF is a renowned organization of The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) provides primary and secondary education to the students up to age of 16 years. Prime objective of the Foundation is to take all such measures that deem necessary for the promotions, improvement and financing of education development of human resource in KP by strengthening 'Elementary and Secondary Education' in the private sector in line with the education policy of the Government.

The Elementary & Secondary Education Foundation established GCSs to serve Out - of Schools Children (OOSC) belonging to families lacking access to educational opportunities. These schools were established in those areas where government is NOT providing schooling facilities.

GCSs are located in a room donated by community members. The teachers from community, teach and Village Education Committee manages the school's activities. They follow the primary school curriculum, and the government provides free textbooks and teaching resources, and pays teachers' honorarium.

School Supportive Program (SSP), whose old name was Iqra Farogh-e-Taleem is a special initiative of the KP Government with the objective of enrolling OOSC falling in the age bracket from 4 years to 16 years.

It has been noted that ESEF prefers Female Teachers. In areas like Tank, Torghar ESEF inducts Male Teachers due to unavailability of female teachers for smooth and necessary continuation of Education process in KP.

# 5.1: Education Support Scheme (ESS) Timeline

In 2014, the scheme started in 6 UCs of Peshawar with target of 3,000 students. 773 students were enrolled in 26 private schools. In 2015, 30,000 OOSC in 6 districts were identified. 16,455 students were enrolled in 231 private schools. In 2017, 25,355 students were enrolled in 285 private schools. In 2018, Bureau of Statistics shared enrollment data of 71,330 students in 1,401 private schools.




# 6. CP's Demographics

# **6.1 CP's Gender Proportion:**

Out of 4,000 teachers of ESEF community schools, some 103 teachers were shortlisted to train them as 'Master Trainer'. Out of which 87 participants were females and only 16 were male teachers. Theses participants came from all over KP.
